YARD SALE

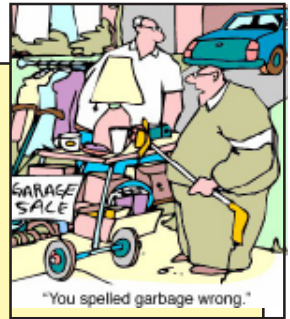

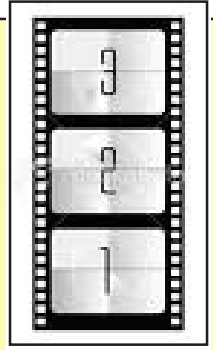
